☆ Important Camp Details for All Campers ☆

❖ Camp Departure and Return Times:

Monday, August 3rd

- Check-in at Sunset Presbyterian East Entry by 1:30 pm at the latest
- Depart Sunset Presbyterian Church at 2:00 pm

Saturday, August 8th

- Depart OSU at 8:30 am
- Arrive Newport at 10:00 am
- Depart Newport at 3:00 pm
- Arrive SPC at 5:30 pm

❖ What to Expect:

- **Encounter Quiet Times:** Time for you to speak to God one-on-one. Adults and teens meet in the auditorium with their Bibles and then disperse to various parts of the campus for approximately 25-30 minutes. Specific Bible passages and devotional thoughts pertaining to the topic of the day are provided in the student magazines.
- **D-Groups:** Small group of teens that meets daily for Bible Study, discussion and fellowship; centered on the topic of the day, D-Groups meet after Encounter each day.
- **AM and Evening Sessions:** Morning and Evening sessions filled with worship and dynamic speakers, media and art, along with a time for decisions.
- **Youth Group Time:** Time for our youth group to discuss the day's events and to draw closer as a youth group. Various group activities will take place during Youth Group Time.
- **The Alternative:** The Alternative is a free time activity on the afternoon of Day 3 to showcase your talents and hang out with friends. Your talents can be anything from singing to poetry to ballet, etc. To secure your spot, please sign up at The CIY Station by the morning of the Alternative. Musicians will need to bring their own amps, guitars, etc. The only sound provided will be similar to a garage set up. This will be a small sound board with only 6 channels, a couple microphones and 2 direct boxes. You will be allowed to do one song (4 minute maximum length). Lyrically Christian themes are encouraged, but not required. All styles are acceptable, but when it comes to the lyrics, keep it clean!
- **Note:** There will not be room on the busses for drum sets, keyboards, large amps, etc. Sorry, but only guitars or smaller instruments can travel, and Sunset will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged instruments/equipment brought to camp for The Alternative.

❖ What Not to Bring:

- Alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc.
- CD players, iPods, MP3 player, radios, TV's, etc.
[Note: Sunset is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items on this list brought to camp.]
- Refrigerators, air-conditioners, Chihuahuas, cottage cheese.

☆ Important Camp Details for All Campers ☆

❖ What to Bring:

- Bible [Must have! If you don't own one, please let me know.]
- Notebook and pen or pencil
- Clothing for 6 days [**Note:** Please see attached dress code, especially re: swimsuits]
 - ❑ Students should bring at least one pair of athletic shoes; also, please pack lightly, in a soft-sided duffle bag; if you can't carry your own stuff in one trip, you've packed too much!
- Athletic equipment for free time (optional)
[**Note:** small items only: Frisbee, Soccer ball or Football, Glove and Ball, Etc.]
- Pillow and sleeping bag
- Camera
- Personal toiletry items, prescription medicines
- Money for travel, The CIY Station (clothing and camp gear), offering, coffee, beach day, etc.
[**Note:** \$20-25 is adequate, but no student **MUST** bring extra cash; all camp meals are covered in the registration fee...this money is simply for extras.]

❖ MOVE Rules:

Camp staff reserves the right to dismiss any youth or adult who cannot abide by these rules.

1. Respect others and yourself.
2. Alcohol or drug use is absolutely prohibited.
3. No guys in girl's dorms beyond the front lobby and no girls in guy's dorms beyond the front lobby.
4. Everyone must be in dorms by designated "In Dorm Time." Quiet hours to be observed after 10 pm.
5. No students with backpacks are allowed in the auditorium or cafeteria.
6. Be where you are supposed to be – when you are supposed to be there. Follow the schedule.
7. Stay in your seating area during worship.
8. Do not leave the auditorium once the speaker begins talking.
9. Respect the campus – No TP, water balloons, shaving cream, sidewalk chalk, etc.
10. Please don't block sidewalks or stairs with D-groups.
11. Do not move screens & furniture – You will be charged for anything damaged, destroyed, or moved.
12. No phone use after midnight (cell phones or dorm phones).
13. Please do not dial 911 unless it is an emergency.
14. No food deliveries of any kind to the campus.
15. Absolutely no fireworks.
